

Sir,

I am directed to refer to references mentioned above and FCI's letter no. Silo/362/Action Plan/Hub & Spoke/2021/Vol.I dated 04.01.2022 on the subject cited above and to convey the approval of competent authority on the following proposals:-

- (a) Additional capacity of 2.75 LMT at 8 locations proposed under Hub & Spoke model in DBFOT mode.
- (b) Storage gap assessment for construction of silos based upon requirement of storage capacity in consuming areas assuming storage equivalent to 24 months allotment of wheat & 4 months of rice under NFSA alongwith consideration of de-hiring of hired capacity in the reference area, if capacity is not required. However, this formula will be used only to arrive at specific locations for construction of silos within a state where land is owned by FCI and will not affect the overall statewide storage gap assessment which is based on approved calculation method [17.75 months wheat and 4 months rice].
