Minutes of 45th High Level Committee (HLC) meeting on Private Subject: Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme- Construction of godowns in Assam and Meghalaya.

Sir.

I am directed to refer to your letters No. E.3(28)/08/HLC/Stg.IV/Vol.IV/212 08.01.2016 and 28.03.2016 on the subject cited above and to convey the approval of this Department to the proposal for construction of godowns of 15.000 MT capacity in Meghalaya under DEC. Scheme.

However, with regard to the proposal for construction of godowns of 1,72,000 MT capacity in Assam it is seen that there is no deficiency in storage capacity after taking into account the balance quantity available in Plan Scheme (except capacity for which land is not yet available, and the capacity of silo sanctioned for Changsari (Assam). Hence, capacity creation under PEG Scheme is not approved.
