## Department of Food & Public Distribution

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Follow up Actions consequent to the Address of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India to Secretaries of the Government of India on 04.06.2014:

- (i) All existing laws, rules and regulations may be examined with a view to necessary amendments, abrogation if required. In this context, CWC may be asked to examine whether it would prefer functioning under the provisions of Companies Act as against the present Central Warehousing Corporation Act. A detail report in this regard may be obtained from the CWC.
- (ii) Convergence of scheme should be ensured wherever possible. In this context, directions may be issued to CWC, CRWC, WDRA, ED (Storage), FCI that e-tendering procedure should be adopted.
- (iii) E-governance practices should be adopted on priority basis. E-tendering procedure should be adopted and at the same time, applications related to all processes should be enabled through online systems and, to the extent possible, decisions taken thereupon should also be conveyed online.
- (iv) Improvement in office ambience and functioning: Joint Secretaries, Directors should ensure inspection of their various sections, ensure timely disposal of files, references, general up-keep, weeding out, cleanliness of office premises. Secretary is expected to take a round on Monday. In the same context, directions may be issued to CWC, CRWC, WDRA.
- (v) Public grievances should be attended and disposed off on priority basis.
- (vi) The domain relevant issues in the "Manifesto" may be studied in detail and needful should be ensured. In case there are difficulties, the same should be conveyed.
- (vii) The targets earmarked by Government in 2009 which have not been achieved should be identified and the reasons examined; and necessary initiatives be taken in this regard.
- (viii) PEG scheme targets should be finalized after cancelling these in respect of States where investors response is not satisfactory. CMD, FCI may be requested to submit his final assessment in this regard.
- (ix) As regards SILOs, the Model Concession Agreement for VGF mode should be finalized at the earliest and as regards non-VGF model, timeline should be set as to when the work orders would be issued and construction work commenced. ED (Storage), FCI should be asked to submit a timeline in accordance with the projects under non-VGF mode and JS (Stg.) to ensure that the Model Concession Agreement for VGF Model should be finalized at the earliest.
