I am directed to refer to your letter No.S&C/Silos/Genl.Corres/2016/3457 dated 03.06.2016 on the subject cited above and to say that the HLC for silos in FCI was constituted by this Department to look into the entire gamut of silo construction keeping in view the overall storage scenario in each State Zone as is done in the case of PEG scheme. The proposals of various State Govts./Agencies for construction of silos may be examined and recommended by HLC before submission for the consideration of this Department.

2. It is also suggested that FCI may approach this Department with HLC's recommendation for any policy changes, if and when required. With regard to the issue of payment of administrative charges to State Agencies, the decision has already been communicated vide our letter of even no. dated 24.06.2016.
