**Subject:** Creation of additional storage capacity under Private Entrepreneurs Gurantee (PEG) Scheme.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter of even number dated 28.07.2008 and 08.04.2010 regarding scheme for construction of godowns through private entrepreneurs for Non DCP States and DCP States respectively.

2. In some of the States, requirement of additional storage space has been felt, after the storage capacities required were worked out under the guarantee schemes referred above. This has been mainly due to substantial increase in procurement in some States since the capacities were worked out and in some due to the inherent potential to increase procurement once the storage infrastructure is put in place.

In this regard, it is stated that for States needing additional storage capacity in view of special circumstances, the need should be first examined by the SIC/HLC and, wherever necessary, HLC may recommend deserving cases to Government for examination in consultation with Internal Finance Division for relaxation of guidelines to allow HLC to consider sanction of additional storage capacity.

4. All other provisions of the Scheme and subsequent modifications will remain unchanged.
